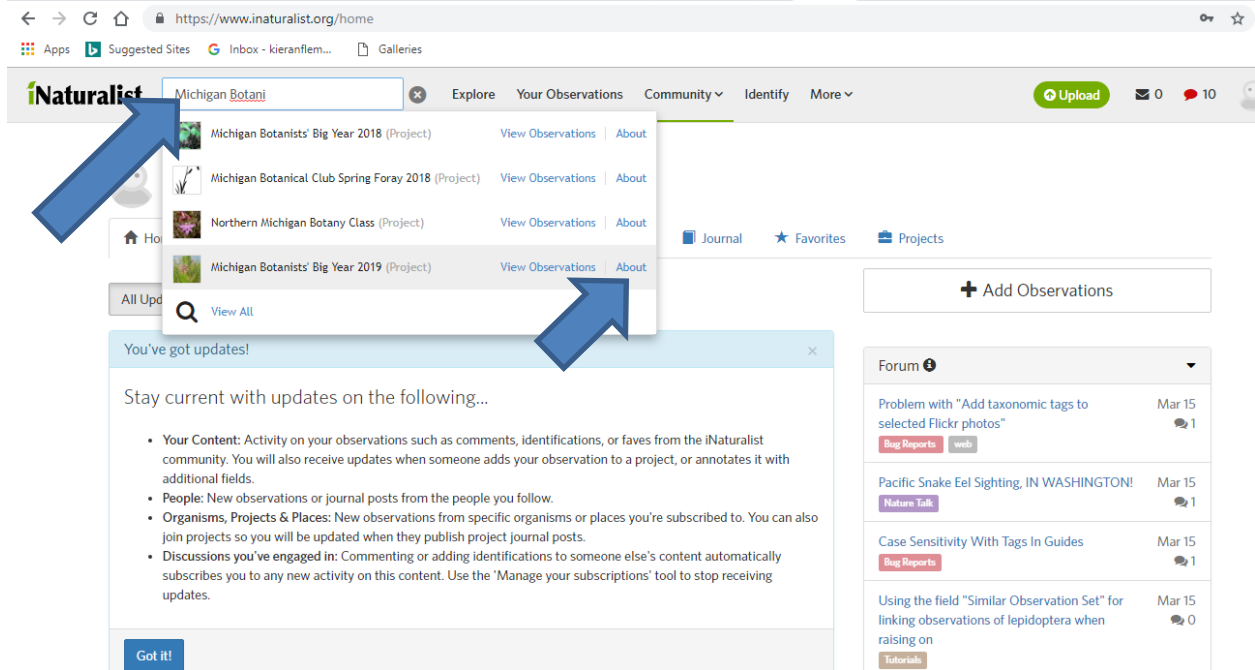
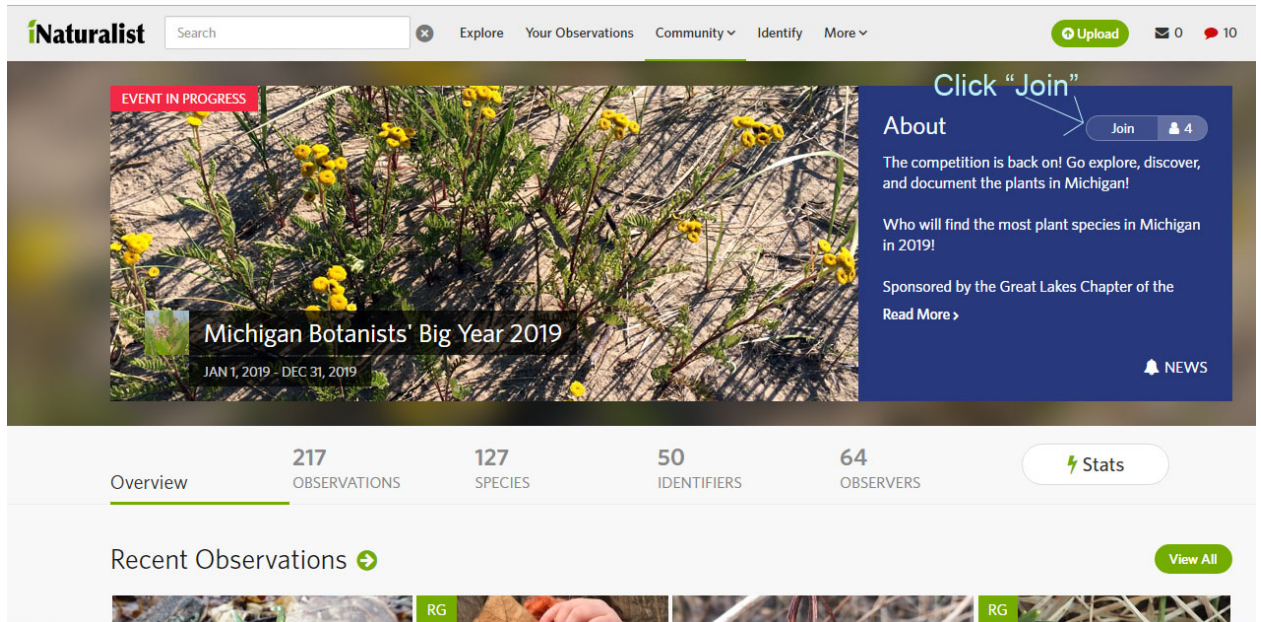


**Join a project (like the Michigan Botanists' Big Year Challenge) by:**
